75 year old female presenting with "fatigue"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking with psychiatric assessment • Communication skills
35 year old female complaining of tingling and "loss of sensation in thumb, and fingers".	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and physical assessment • Communication skills
45 year old male admitted five days previously with "chest pain".	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and risk assessment • Counselling
58 year old female presenting with difficulty sleeping, "headaches, loss of appetite", and feeling as though "on an emotional roller coaster".	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and risk management • Counselling with special for suicidal tendencies
64 year old female complaining of "severe leg pain".	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and physical assessment • Management and information sharing
48 year old male complaining of a "fever after (three days) cholecystectomy".	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and physical assessment
62 year old male arrives to discuss the "results of a CT scan" of his head.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking • Counselling and breaking bad news
35 year old female who wants to discuss her risk of getting breast cancer after her "younger sister was just diagnosed"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History taking and risk assessment • Counselling
